Trunk Show By Fiber Artist Mary Bajcz

We will welcome fiber artist Mary Bajcz of Milford, MI to our September meeting to share her unique style and approaches.

This how Mary describes her style:

"Free cut piecing popped into my life in 2000 and it's how I've made quilts ever since. I stack up fabrics, cut shapes into the stack, rearrange the pieces within the stack and sew them back together. I've pieced birds, flowers, peace signs, licorice all sorts, landscapes, and all kinds of traditional blocks using this method.

I wondered why I loved this way of working so much and decided it was the serendipity involved. I don't quite know where things are going when I work and that keeps me interested and entertained every step of the way. I've been studying the subject of serendipity for the past 19 years and love to talk about it and the way it can bless our quiltmaking and lives."

GLAAQN INSURANCE: We now have insurance that will cover the Show. Please note that GLAAQN's maximum liability is set at \$300. The check in form that members will complete and sign when quilts are dropped off will include an acknowledgement of the liability as stated and the opportunity to identify the value of your quilt.

QUILT CHECK IN (IMPORTANT): If you have a quilt in the show, please make sure that you pick up, complete and sign the form that will be available at the Sept. 7 meeting. You will receive your assigned drop off time that will be based on the location of your quilt at the September meeting. Plan to stay 30-45 minutes to assist with hanging your quilt. If you are not able to attend the meeting, you have to contact Pat Millender BEFORE September 7 via email at plmillender@gmail.com or 313-418-9757. Thank you for helping to make our show a success.

TICKET SALES: September 7 is the last day to turn in ticket monies or unsold tickets. If you are unable to attend the meeting, please contact Jackie Ollison (ollisonjLsL23@aol.com or 313-892-0426) to arrange to turn in your money or tickets before the Sept 7 meeting. DO NOT BRING TICKETS OR MONEY TO THE SEPT. 27 SET UP DAY.

VOLUNTEER SIGN UPS:

We still need more volunteers on all days and especially on Friday, Sept 27 Set Up Day. Please see Karla Middlebrooks at the meeting to sign up for your shift. Members with quilts in the show are required to work a minimum of 4 hours during the show.

PROCEDURES FOR CLASSES AND TEACHERS

The Executive Board recently met to discuss policies and procedures regarding classes to be presented by internal (member) or external (professional) teachers. The following procedures were approved.

Linda Ali will periodically (2 times a year) teach a class to create our official GLAAQN Sash, Great Lakes will pay her a \$125.00 teaching fee and she will charge the students \$10.00 each Payable to her for her time. An additional fee will be paid to Linda for the cost of the GLAAQN patch.

Members teaching special classes in February, April, June, August or October will set their own prices for members who want to attend. GLAAQN will advertise these classes and provide a room where the classes will be held. The teacher is to collect all fees and will have to pay for the room out of their class fees. Keep in mind that a full day at the Center costs \$100.00. Room payment will be made to the GLAAQN Treasurer and the Treasurer will pass the fee on to The Livonia Senior Center. All classes must be discussed and approved with the GLAAQN Vice President.

Network Classes which are taught during our regular meeting month (January, March, May July, September, November), teachers (members) will receive \$125.00 to be paid by the Network. These classes will only run about 2 hours (unless otherwise approved by the Board) because we have to be out of the center by 1:00pm. Any class supply or kit fees will be paid by the attendees to the teacher.

All outside teachers or professional (non-member) teachers must be approved by the Board before any contracts are signed. Payments will be set by the teacher and the Board will negotiate directly with the teacher. Members are responsible for any kit fees directly payable to the teacher.
